

# Governance Nomination Criteria

## Nomination Criteria by Position

### SRCD President-Elect

**To serve as President-Elect, the elected individual must be either:**

- a Professional member of SRCD (with a doctoral degree or equivalent), or
- an LMIC (Low and Middle Income Countries) member of SRCD (with a doctoral degree or equivalent)

Each nomination requires the nominee's curriculum vitae and a brief statement of their interests and qualifications.

### SRCD Treasurer

**To serve as Treasurer, the elected individual must be either:**

- a Professional member of SRCD (with a doctoral degree or equivalent), or

- an LMIC (Low and Middle Income Countries) member of SRCD (with a doctoral degree or equivalent).

## SRCD Governing Council Members-At-Large

---

**To serve as Members-At-Large on the Governing Council, those elected and appointed must be either:**

- a Professional member of SRCD (with a doctoral degree or equivalent),
- an Early Career member of SRCD (with a doctoral degree or equivalent), or
- an LMIC (Low and Middle Income Countries) member of SRCD (with a doctoral degree or equivalent).

Each nomination requires the nominee's curriculum vitae and a brief statement of their interests and qualifications.

## SRCD Committee Members

---

**To serve as a member of an SRCD Committee, appointees must be either:**

- a Professional member of SRCD (with a doctoral degree or equivalent),
- an Early Career member of SRCD (with a doctoral degree or equivalent), or

- an LMIC (Low and Middle Income Countries) member of SRCD (with a doctoral degree or equivalent).

Each nomination requires the nominee's curriculum vitae and a brief statement of their interests and qualifications.

---

## Student and Early Career Council (SECC) Representatives to SRCD Committees

---

**To serve as a SECC Representative to SRCD Committees, those elected must be:**

- in their second year of doctoral studies and beyond, but no more than **one (1)** year post-doctoral degree (or equivalent).

Preference will be given to nominees who have been an SRCD member for at least a year. Each nomination requires the nominee's curriculum vitae.
